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Questionnaire Depression

At least **two** of the following symptoms are present.

- 1. Depressive mood to an extent clearly unusual for those affected, most of the day, almost every day, essentially unaffected by the circumstances and lasting for at least two weeks
- 2. Loss of interest or enjoyment in activities that used to be enjoyable
- 3. Reduced propulsion or increased fatigue

One or more of the following additional symptoms up to a total of four

- 1. Loss of self-confidence or self-esteem
- 2. Unfounded self-reproaches or pronounced, inappropriate feelings of guilt
- 3. Recurring thoughts of death or suicide
- 4. Complaints or evidence of reduced thinking or ability to concentrate, hesitation or indecision
- 5. Psychomotor restlessness or inhibition
- 6. Sleep disorders of all kinds
- 7. Loss of appetite or increased appetite with a corresponding change in weight
